RULE 6.8 SUBSTITUTE NUMBER BOARDS (PREMIER & DIVISION ONE ONLY)

All clubs are **once again** reminded that the use of **Substitute Number Boards** is **mandatory** in **all Step 5 & 6 NLS** fixtures (Premier & Division One),

No excuses or discussion on this subject will be accepted.

Match Officials are also aware of this requirement, and in future any breaches reported to us, are likely to result in clubs being fined.

RULE 8.14 PRODUCTION OF MATCH PROGRAMME (PREMIER; DIVISION ONE & TWO)

Once again, SCFL will be undertaking checks to ensure that all clubs do comply with the Rules regarding programmes.

ALL CLUBS must forward copy of an early season match programme to SCFL no later than 30th

WEEKLY ROUND-UP

Overall, a mixed bag of results for our clubs in the FA Cup; with **Six** definitely through to the next round, with a further four facing midweek replays.

Best Result was probably Eastbourne United, in winning away at step 4 club Phoenix Sports (Isthmian League SE) 2-1 thanks to a George Olulode winning deep into added time.

Peacehaven, and Crawley Down Gatwick meanwhile both did well to draw away at step 4 opposition, and now enjoy home advantage in Tuesdays replays.

The Anvils held Sussex rivals Three Bridges 2-2 at Jubilee Road, thanks to a Ben Chowney brace, the equaliser coming deep in added time, while Peacehaven drew 1-1 at Isthmian South-Central side Chipstead.

Steyning Town won comfortably 4-0 away at Balham (CoCo Lge.), and Midhurst also did well, winning away at Holmesdale (SCEFL)

Crowborough Athletic & Newhaven are also through to the Preliminary Round after winning against fellow SCFL opponents. The Crows defeated Shoreham **3-0**, while a Callum Edwards hat-trick saw the Dockers overcome Little Common **3-1**.

Playing on Sunday afternoon, Bexhill United overcame North Greenford United (CoCo Lge.) 3-1, thanks to a brace from James Stone.

Hassocks also face mid-week replay, at Erith Town (SCEFL) after being held 1-1 at the Beacon, and ACF Uckfield must travel to Ashford Town (Middx) on Tuesday after yesterday's tie was washed out.

The opening day In Division One yesterday saw a deluge of goals (as well as rain !!!) with 36 goals coming from just eight games played. Highlight was undoubtedly at Crabtree Park, as newly relegated Roffey and Wick who lost out on promotion in the play-off final shared as astonishing eight goals!

Roffey coming from 3-1 down to lead 4-3 late in the game, before a Johan Van-Driel last minute equaliser.

There were Seven at both Chessington, as the home side comfortably saw off Billingshurst 5-2, thanks to two apiece from Bailey Ellis & Mo Black., and also at Worthing United, as the home side eventually overcame Copthorne 4-3. The visitors on the debut in Senior Football suffered a nightmare start and trailed 4-0 in just over half an hour – before rallying well enough to ensure that the home side well left hanging on for the points in the end.

There was another very late winner, this time at Seaford as Tyler Capon's late effort edged out the other relegated side, Alfold 3-2. Forest Row, who struggled for much of last season enjoyed an impressive 4-0 win at Mile Oak, with a brace here from Matty Feeny-Hill.

Meanwhile Montpelier Villa who also struggled last season pulled off an impressive 2-0 win away at Dorking Wanderers B, thanks to a Jesse Burbidge brace.

Oakwood overcame Arundel 2-1; while the game between Godalming Town & Selsey bucked the trend by remaining goalless.
